## WG goal: finalise the new SRA/MDS - timeline

### ❑ **24/09/13 – WG meetings:**

- every WG to update its section of the SRA/MDS - the new text shouldn't be longer than the one in the current version of the document.
- WGs should reach an agreement on the SRA/MDS contents – last chance to involve all TPWind members.

### ❑ **25/09/13 - Follow-up meeting:** discussion on the next steps and potential potential overlaps in the text developed by the various WGs.

### ❑ If necessary, the Secretariat will organise new meetings with WG Chairs and Secretaries over the coming weeks to finalise the text of the SRA/MDS.

### ❑ **October- November 2013:** Secretariat to collect all input and draft the final document.

## WG goal: finalise the new SRA/MDS – timeline (II)

- ❑ **December 2013 (TBC):** Once completed, and before its publication, the SRA/MDS will have to be revised and validated by the SC
- ❑ **January – February 2014:** proofreading, designing and printing (EWEA)
- ❑ **March 2014:** official launch of the SRA/MDS in Barcelona at EWEA 2014.

## Next steps

- ❑ Following the 16<sup>th</sup> SC meeting and the 3<sup>rd</sup> Energy Event, TPWind will:
  - Finalise the SRA/MDS;
  - Launch the renewal of the Platform: new WG and SC members will have to be in place by spring 2014.
- ❑ 10<sup>th</sup> GA: May – June 2014 (*date TBD*), once new members will be in place.
- ❑ 17<sup>th</sup> SC meeting: May – June 2014 (*date TBD*). At that meeting, new SC members will elect the new ExCo, which, in turn, will appoint the new TPWind Chair (*Mr. Kruse's mandate will expire at the 17<sup>th</sup> SC meeting*).
- ❑ **Funding TPWind**: TOPWind, will end in April 2014. As from spring 2014, TPWind will be funded by a new EU project.
