Day one Working Group meetings (I)

q SRA/MDS Implementation Plan:

- § Are WG members satisfied with the SRA/MDS Implementation Plan?
- § Does it reflect the concerns and objectives of the WG?
- § Would WG members recommend specific improvements to the text?
- § What are the projects (relevant to the WG) that should be launched first (i.e. in the beginning of 2010)?
- § For each of these projects, a detailed action plan should be drafted. In order to be effective and credible, action plans should identify at least the following elements: sought partners, concrete activities to be implemented (if possible split into work packages), desired timeline, foreseen budget and ideal sources of funding.
- § How can TPWind and its Secretariat provide support in the development and implementation of the identified projects (e.g. acting as a help-desk, providing inputs on project ideas, identifying relevant partners outside the Platform, lobbying EU Institutions in order to obtain the necessary funding, monitoring the implementation of projects and reporting to TPWind members...)?
- § Can WG members already identify potential sources of funding for the selected projects at national level?
- § For Working Groups 2 and 4 only: which of the projects identified by TPWind or ESTEP could be implemented together and under which conditions?

Day one Working Group meetings (II)

q EWI:

- § Are WG members satisfied with the EWI?
- § Does it reflect the concerns and objectives of the WG?
- § Do WG members have questions on the contents of the EWI?
- § Can WG members provide elements to improve the budget evaluation (i.e. Annex II of the EWI)?
- § Can WG members provide elements to improve the proposed KPIs (key performance indicators, i.e. Annex III of the EWI)?

q Action Plan on the future of TPWind:

- § Are WG members satisfied with the proposed plan?
- § Does it reflect the concerns and objectives of the WG?
- § Would WG members recommend specific improvements to the text?
- § Which organizations should be targeted first in order to optimize external cooperation activities (e.g. other European Technology Platforms, Research Institutes, NGOs, Associations...)?
- § What are the recommendations of the WG in terms of implementation of the proposed blocks of activities (projects, cooperation and dissemination)?
- § What are the expectations of the WG in terms of future growth and role of the European Wind Energy Technology Platform?

Implementation of TPWind 4th General Assembly

- q The title of the 4th General Assembly is “Building the future of wind energy”, because TPWind members will be required to move forward in the implementation of the SRA/MDS projects and to comment on the EWI and on the Action Plan on the future of TPWind
- q TPWind chairs and vice-chairs are therefore going to play a key role: the success of day one meetings, and therefore of the Assembly, will very much depend on them and on their ability to manage their Working Groups
- q TPWind chairs and vice-chairs will report on the results of Working Groups meetings during the plenary session
- q Working Groups Secretaries will be in charge of developing the minutes, which will be then forwarded to the Secretariat for filing and processing
- q During the plenary session, Norela Constantinescu (DG TREN) will represent the European Commission

After the 4th General Assembly: next steps

- q Following the 4th General Assembly, TPWind will be in the position to:
 - § Identify the most urgent and mature SRA/MDS projects, which will then be presented to the EC, EACI and EIB in order to be included in 2011 - 2012 FP7 and IEE calls (as well in the future funding priorities of the European Investment Bank);
 - § Finalize the EWI, by taking into consideration TPWind members comments;
 - § Finalize the Action Plan on the future of TPWind, so as to present it at the 5th General Assembly and put it into motion towards the end of 2009.
- q The 5th General Assembly will take place in October / November 2009, while the 6th one in March 2010
- q The 5th and the 6th General Assemblies will last for one day only
- q As from 2010 (i.e. after the end of the Windsec project), there will be only one General Assembly per year: the 7th one will therefore be organized between March and May 2011
